- Enable effective feedback by increasing understanding of the outcome desired and how this might best be achieved in different circumstances
- Consider what is differential attainment and what supervisors can do to address learning environment factors
- Review the four learning styles identified by Honey and Mumford, identify own, and reflect on how knowledge of these might influence your work as educators
- Consider generational differences and how they might affect the workplace training environment. Develop an approach to use this as a tool without stereotyping
